

**RESOLUTION NO. 2024-13**

**A RESOLUTION IMPOSING FIRE RESTRICTIONS IN THE DRUMMOND TOWN PARK.**

**WHEREAS**, Granite County has imposed Stage 1 fire restrictions which prohibit building a campfire except for in a developed or improved recreation site, and


**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Town Council, have grave concerns regarding campfires in the Drummond Town Park (a developed or improved recreation site) because of the highly dry conditions and the lack of direct supervision over people camping in the park, and


**WHEREAS**, the Town Council has the power under MCA 7-5-4101 to make and pass resolutions necessary for the management of its affairs, and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Council has the power under MCA 7-33-4206 to regulate bonfires, fireworks, and other fire-causing agents.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF DRUMMOND, MONTANA**, that the Town prohibits any type of campfire in the Drummond Town Park while Granite County has fire restrictions in place. Once Granite County has lifted its fire restrictions, the Town's prohibition of campfires in the Drummond Town Park shall be lifted.
