



****UPDATE - Live Briefing on Wednesday Damaging Wind Event**

In conjunction, with our fellow Montana offices we invite you to join us for a live briefing at 2 pm, 16 December, for the coming damaging wind event.

KEY POINTS

- Widespread damaging winds are expected Wednesday for western Montana
- Antecedent warm and wet conditions have left soils saturated, elevating tree blow over potential
- Bitterroot Valley could experience peak wind gusts 80 to 100 mph
- North to south stretches of exposed roads will be susceptible to high profile vehicle blow overs
